NOT ALLOWED

- Sandals of any kind. This includes Birkenstock sandals.
- Games & Electronics: ipods or mp3 players, cd players, dvd players, gameboys, etc.
- Cellphones

Should any of these items be taken on any camp out they will be confiscated and returned at the Scoutmasters discretion.

Summer Camps we allow snacks as follows:

Snacks are allowed but only six total, drinks, chips, candy. If a Scout is found to have more than his quota it will be confiscated.

When sending a scout on a camp out please do not send him with anything new.

The troop will not be held responsible for lost property.

These rules are in place for a reason please for your own sake and that of your son's abide by them.

The fee for weekend camping trips to Camp Kootaga is \$15.00, (covers the cost of food and reservations).

Permission slips need to be turned in the week prior to the camp out. Permission Slips can be found in the scout hall or online.
